

Vision: Each child attending Howard County public schools has access to the education, aspirations, and opportunities needed to succeed at school and in life.

Mission: Bright Minds enhances the educational experiences of all Howard County Public School System students by bringing together private and community support for academic initiatives and opportunities.

Our Impact

Computers for Students: Helping bridge the digital divide for Howard County students who lack access to technology at home. We work with HCPSS to identify students, and then provide them with technology, training and resources for low-cost internet access. Students are able to use the technology for critical tasks, including homework, research, ACT/SAT preparation and college applications.

Staff and Teacher Grants: Awarding competitive annual grants to HCPSS teachers and staff to support innovative instructional projects that build 21st century skills in areas such as health, business, fine arts, STEM, technology, and the humanities. Examples of projects that have been funded include a Buddy Bench at Bellows Spring Elementary School to encourage playing with others and making new friends, and Rho Kappa Oral History Project at Howard High School where students interview Howard alumni dating back to the school's inception in 1952.

Student Scholarships: Providing Bright Minds-funded scholarships and administering third-party named and funded scholarships to students. Scholarships support students attending post-secondary institutions and also HCPSS programs that charge tuition, such as summer school. These scholarships help students who may not otherwise have the opportunity to attend post-secondary institution or participate in fee-based offerings.

Student Support for JumpStart: Helping students develop skills, earn college credits, and explore career options by covering the costs of books and fees for income-eligible students participating in JumpStart, the dual-enrollment partnership between HCPSS and Howard Community College. We are committed to ensuring all students have the chance to take advantage of the JumpStart program.

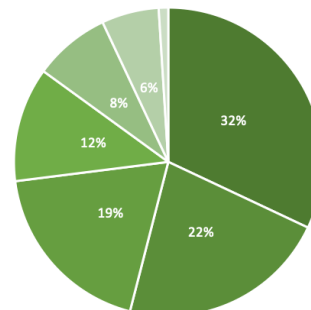
Read With Me • Howard County: Providing one book a month to children from birth to age five to help build a home library and expand support and resources to ensure that all children in Howard County enter school ready to succeed. This pilot program is an affiliate of Dolly Parton's Imagination Library and currently serves the following school communities: Cradlerock, Deep Run, Laurel Woods, Phelps Luck, Swansfield and Talbott Springs elementary schools. We partnered with HCPSS, Howard County Government and the Howard County Early Childhood Advisory Council to establish the pilot.
